In each step, you'll take on ONE exciting activity with easy-to-follow instructions to guide you.

Step 1: We Love Wildlife

Start your journey by reflecting on the diversity of wildlife in your area

Step 2: Pollinator Pals – Help bees, butterflies & other pollinators with ONE of these activities

- **Pollinator Palaces:** Build simple spots for pollinators to rest and refuel
- **No Mow May:** Give hungry pollinators a feast by skipping mowing in May
- **Trees for Bees:** Help bees by helping trees

Step 3: Nurture Nature – Foster a connection to nature with ONE of these activities

- **Animal-Friendly Zone:** Make your schoolyard an animal-friendly zone
- **Dark Skies, Happy Animals:** Take action against light pollution
- **Temporary Natural Art:** Create temporary art using natural materials

Step 4: Local Love – Support the local ecosystem with ONE of these activities

- **Seed Bomb Squad:** Make seed bombs with native plants to grow more local flowers
- **Weed Warriors:** Explore the schoolyard and remove harmful invasive plants
- **Clean Air Champions:** Promote an idle-free area
